Gradual resumption of activities in the context of COVID-19: Indoor shows resume at Château Scènes

Châteauguay, March 30, 2021 – Ville de Châteauguay is proud to announce that indoor shows will resume in mid-April for its Château Scènes broadcast program. Thanks to the recently announced additional assistance of the Ministère de la Culture, the team is currently working on preparing a program of shows at the Pavillon de l'île for April, May and June.

Many varied and popular artists will be back on stage after a long performance hiatus—for them too—including, to our great delight: Arnaud Soly, Damien Robitaille, Dominique Fils-Aimé and the group É.T.É, to name a few. We will even host here, in Châteauguay, the revival of a great Canadian theatre classic: La Sagouine by Antonine Maillet, performed by Lorrain Côté!

Given the COVID-19 restrictions, the number of tickets will be limited to between 70 and 90 spectators per show. Wearing a mask is mandatory for everyone, and tickets are allocated according to the compulsory distance of 1.5 metres between each individual or family bubble. The Café de l'île bistro will be closed.

Improved ticket office

To avoid queues at the ticket office, online and telephone purchases are preferred. The new TUXEDO ticket office will also simplify the procedure by sending electronic tickets by email.

Holders of a valid Passeport-loisirs receive a \$2 discount on the vast majority of shows offered, even when purchasing online. To benefit from this discount, holders of valid Passeports-loisirs must activate their member profile by contacting the ticket office for the first time at 450-698-3100. This member status also offers spontaneous discounts at the ticket office (broadcaster's best pick, show combos, last-minute deals, among others). Tickets will go on sale **starting Tuesday, April 6 at noon**.

Postponed shows

Regarding the postponed shows over the last few months, the new dates are now available on our [website](#). The tickets still available have been put back on sale. Ticket holders must keep their old tickets. Those for whom the new date is not suitable can obtain a refund by contacting the ticket office at 450-698-3100.
