Three screenings per film

Due to restrictions related to COVID-19, the Ciné-Club screenings will take place on Mondays from April 12 to June 14 at 10:00 a.m., 1:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. in the Salle Jean-Pierre-Houde at the Centre culturel Georges-P. Vanier (15 Boulevard Maple). Masks are mandatory for everyone, and tickets will be distributed based on the mandatory 1.5-metre distance between every individual or family bubble.

The regular price of admission is \$7 and a \$1 discount is granted to people with a Passeport-Loisir. It is best to get your tickets in advance on the Châteauguay website. Tickets can also be purchased by calling this number. The official sale will begin on Wednesday, March 31, at noon.
