Invitation to the inauguration of the urban pollinator gardens

Châteauguay, September 22, 2021 - Ville de Châteauguay, in partnership with Miel Montréal,

will inaugurate the *urban pollinator gardens* on Sunday, September 26, 2021.

Citizen participation project

The pollinator gardens project aims to rehabilitate a natural site by planting plants known for

attracting insect pollinators. Over the next three years, over 1,500 plants will be planted in a

2,800 square metre protected area surrounded by boulevard Rameau, rue Poupart, boulevard

Kennedy and carré du Zodiaque. It is also a privileged opportunity for residents to contribute to

the transformation of their living environment by developing natural areas that encourage

biodiversity.

Inauguration day*

During the inauguration on September 26, 2021 at 2 p.m., in the presence of the Mayor and

elected officials at Ville de Châteauguay and representatives of Miel Montréal, visitors will be

able to access the gardens located close to **boulevard Rameau** (between numbers 220 and 224).

For this occasion, guided visits of the gardens will be organized. Miel Montréal will also run an

awareness booth to answer residents' questions.

* If it's raining, the event will be postponed to Saturday, October 2. The announcement will be

published on the city's Facebook page on Friday, September 24.

The event will be held in compliance with current public health restrictions and social distancing

rules.
