Preventive Boil Water Advisory extended for 24 hours

For the entire aqueduct network of Ville de Châteauguay and municipalities served

Châteauguay, January 31, 2024 – The preventive boil water advisory issued on January 29, in effect for Châteauguay and all other municipalities served by its water supply network namely Mercier, Léry, Saint-Urbain-Premier, Sainte-Martine and Saint-Isidore (Petit Rang and Grande-Ligne sector), is extended for 24 hours.

Water samples sent to an accredited laboratory are still under analysis. Consequently, the boil water advisory is extended for 24 hours as a precaution, in order to obtain the results of the analyses.

What should you do?

You should **boil water for at least one (1) minute** or use **boiled or bottled water** for drinking, brush your teeth, make ice cubes, and wash and prepare food until further notice.

You can use unboiled tap water to shower, bathe or wash your dishes or clothes. For young children, it is recommended to put very little water in the bathtub, so that they cannot swallow it, and not to let them play in the water.
